Guidelines for making FYP videos

Dear students,

Your FYP video will be made available to the whole world through departmental YouTube channel, so make amazing and exciting videos with useful content.

You have to submit two videos.

Short video: (3~4 minutes): Animation style with background music (Must use copyright free music)

→ Inside content (2~3 minutes): Journey of FYP from scratch to end with short videos + pics + text labels (Working on hardware, software, achieving final product, results, simulations etc.)

Note: keep taking pictures and making short videos

→ FYP poster (10 to 15 seconds: Full screen poster and then smoothly scroll down)

Long video: Duration of video should be less than 30 minutes.

Voice should be clear, uniform and louder in whole video.

Introduction to team members inside ppt in background + face to face on same time.

Project title, Introduction to Supervisor, co-supervisor



- ➔ FYP Presentation (Same or better version of FYP PPT that you have prepared with the instructions provided by **Dr. Nabeel Siddiqui** for final presentation)
- ➔ FYP demonstration (Hardware, software or both (whichever methodology is adopted and implemented))
- ➔ FYP poster (show actual poster and just tell that you have summarized your work into poster (don't explain again))

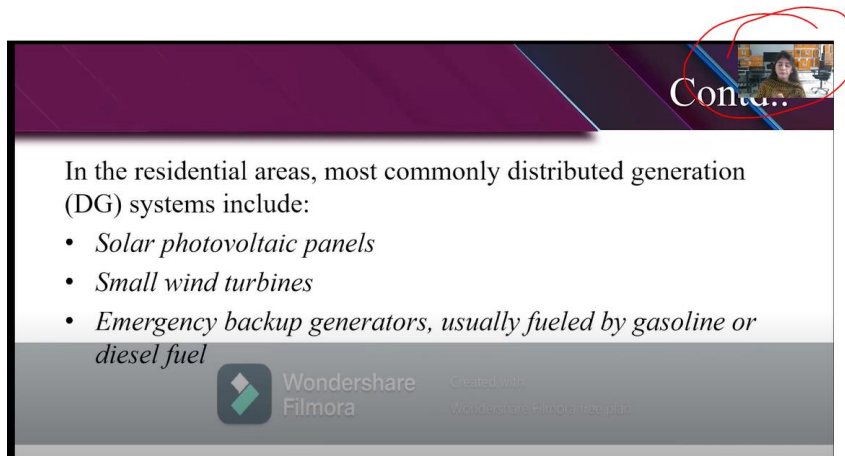
Bring following files through USB:

- (i) Thesis file (PDF, word/editable format is preferred)
- (ii) FYP PPT file
- (iii) FYP Poster in soft form (Editable format)
- (iv) Provide first slide in PPT format

- (v) Provide first slide in image format as well
- (vi) Short video presentation
- (vii) Long video presentation with:
 - a. Use **English** language.
 - b. Use pointer or mouse **cursor** in long video presentation.
 - c. **High quality** video with same dimensions/style as YouTube videos (**not** as **Tick Tock** style)
 - d. **No water marks** of any video recording application.
 - e. **Clear, loud, uniform voice** in whole presentation
 - f. **No shaky** video (Camera should be fixed and move slowly if required)
 - g. **Clearly readable text** in figures/tables, captions, titles, paragraph, software etc.
 - h. **Taskbar** should not be visible in video.
 - i. **No spelling mistakes**
 - j. Proper lighting in surroundings with visible PPT text, no shadows, or extra light reflections/shadows.
 - k. You can use slide/image/video transitions and in-slide animations are very much encouraged.
 - l. Do not stand in front of projected ppt (use LASER pointer).
 - m. If you cannot explain something well, skip it from video or explain briefly with confidence to avoid bad impression worldwide.

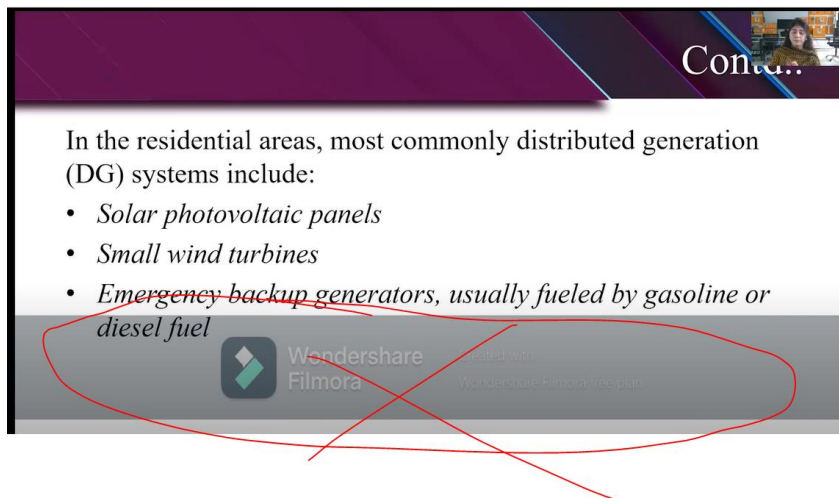
Submit to and get your videos checked by Dr. Abdul Aziz Memon

Recommended screen recording style for long video:

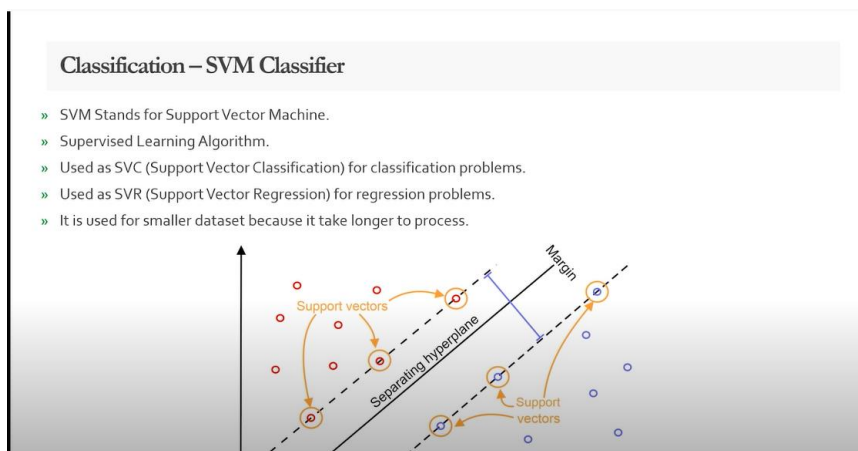
- (i) Small face video + slide + (must use cursor/pointer to point out that particular text/image)



There should be **no** **watermarks** or MS Windows **taskbar**.



Just voice over is not accepted.
